The Coppel Alumnae Panhellenic Association (CAPA) is a non-profit organization. The main goals of this group are to extend the opportunities of sorority life and interpret the Greek system to the Coppel community. This is accomplished by performing valuable community services such as the awarding of scholarships, philanthropic projects, and Greek information programs to prospective college women.

This year, we hope to award two \$500 scholarships for high school seniors planning on attending college full time as freshmen next fall.

Criteria:

The Coppel Alumnae Panhellenic Association (CAPA) is seeking well-rounded graduating high school senior woman (public or private high school) currently residing in the city of Coppel or within CISD Boundaries. Applicant must attend an accredited four-year university with National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) Sororities on campus in the academic year following high school graduation, register for sorority recruitment with CAPA and participate in the sorority recruitment program in their campus.

The applicant will be judged on the following:

- Academics
- Test Scores (SAT/ACT)
- Extra-curricular and volunteer activities
- Leadership
- Essay

Requirements:

Applicants should fill out the application (High School scholarship application is available on the CAPA website www.coppellsororities.com) and supply two letters of recommendation. These letters can come from high school counselors, major subject area teachers, or resource persons within the community. Please attach a copy of your most recent transcript. Applications and necessary information should be sent to the Scholarship Chairman (address above) and must be postmarked by **April 15, 2012**.

The Scholarship Committee of the Coppel Alumnae Panhellenic Association will judge applicants. All applications and information will be kept confidential. Finalists may be asked to attend a personal interview. Scholarships may be awarded at the Coppel High School Awards Assembly.

All recipients must attend college within the ensuing year or forfeit the award. Scholarship Funds will be sent to the recipients upon proof of registration at the college is provided.
