Criteria:

The Coppell Alumnae Panhellenic Association is seeking well-rounded active sorority members who are attending college and permanently reside in the city of Coppell or within the CISD boundaries. The applicant will be judged on the following:

- Academics
- > Extra-curricular and volunteer activities
- Leadership
- > Essay

Requirements:

- A completed application form by a post-marked date of June 30, 2018
- Transcript (can be unofficial) with GPA for the past school year
- > Permanent resident of Coppell/within CISD Boundaries

The Scholarship Committee of the Coppell Alumnae Panhellenic Association will judge applicants. All applications and information will be kept confidential. The scholarship recipient(s) will be **announced by July 28, 2018**. Recipients must attend college within the ensuing year or forfeit the award. Scholarship monies will be sent when proof of registration at the college is provided.
