#### **Criteria:**

The Coppel Alumnae Panhellenic Association is seeking well-rounded active sorority members who are attending college and permanently reside in the city of Coppel or within the CISD boundaries. The applicant will be judged on the following:

- Academics
- Extra-curricular and volunteer activities
- Leadership (sorority, campus, community, etc.)
- Essay

#### **Requirements:**

- **A completed application form post-marked on or before November 15, 2020**
- Transcript (can be unofficial) with GPA for the past school year
- Permanent resident of Coppel/within CISD Boundaries
- Photo (to be used for recipient announcement publicity)

The Scholarship Committee of the Coppel Alumnae Panhellenic Association will review the applications. All applications and information will be kept confidential. The scholarship recipient will be **announced by Dec. 4, 2020**. Recipient must attend college within the ensuing year or forfeit the award. Scholarship monies will be sent directly to the college/university when proof of registration is provided to the Scholarship Committee Chairman.
