Recruitment Process

Round 1 (Go Greek; Open House Round)	Round 2 (Philanthropy; House Tours Round)	Round 3 (Sisterhood; Leadership Round)	Round 4 (Preference Round)
 PNMs visit every NPC sorority on campus. PNMs rank preferences of sororitiesPNM rankings not shared with sororities. 	preferences after parties.	 PNMs are invited to attend fewer sorority parties that are longer in length. Sisterhood and leadership are focus. PNMs rank preferences after parties. 	 PNMs attend max of 2 sorority parties. PNMs rank preferences after parties. Receive a bid from one of the two sororities=bid.

Legacies


- Definitions differ by sorority


