Next Steps after the Sorority Recruitment Forum

1. Register with your Local Alumnae Panhellenic (local area reference chair information and scholarship information).
 Begin to prepare your packet for recommendation writers. Be aware that some sororities accept online recommendations (meaning you will need digital copies of everything). a. Recommendation packet contents include: social resume, and a headshot picture.
3. Find alumnae from each sorority represented at your university's campus to complete your recommendation. Sorority recommendation writers can be found by asking your teachers, neighbors, parent's co-workers, friend's mothers, friend's in organizations like church, etc. Ask the writers if they prefer a paper packet or digital copy. Packets should be distributed to the writers no later than 5/1. Preferred deadlines for writers to complete recommendations is 6/1 or sooner.
4. Review your university's campus Panhellenic website and note any upcoming dates, such as Greek Preview Days or registration deadlines.
5. Register with your university Panhellenic once registration begins. Be aware that late registration fees can be incurred after the deadline. You must do this in order to go through Recruitment at your university!
